Coulwood celebrated our 50th Anniversary as a community in 2008! Coulwood needs more participation in the form of membership in the council and/or the pool to make community activities a reality. By becoming an active member of our community you are providing the necessary means to support the wide variety of programs that benefit the community.

Council Membership (no pool membership) Cost: \$45 per household. The Council membership year runs from May 1st – April 30th. All members of the Coulwood Community Council are entitled to take advantage of: Free Classifieds advertising online on the website (up to five free per household). Other benefits of joining the Council are improved home values, and discounts on rental of the Clubhouse or Pool. Dues are tax-deductible.

Coulwood Clubhouse & Pool Rentals

For renting the Clubhouse & Pool please refer to the website for rental request and rental agreements. A \$100 Security Deposit is required with request for rental. The fees for 2012 are as follows:

Council/Pool Member—Pool \$125 & Clubhouse \$100

NON-MEMBERSHIP—Pool \$250 & Clubhouse \$175.

Pool Membership Guest Benefits:

Coulwood Hills Swim Club is a private swimming pool for paid members. Use by non-members, although welcomed, will have restrictions. If noted that a visiting non-member comes to the pool more than five times a month (using guest privileges of one or more host members) the Pool Manager has the authority to limit further visits. Membership should be considered when frequent usage is desired.

Persons residing within the boundaries of the Coulwood Council membership area may join - they cannot be guests.

The charge for guests is required to be paid to CSCM staff on duty on entering and display a dated wrist band for duration of pool stay as proof of payment and identify as a guest of a host member.

Guest Fees are as follows:

Single Guest, 2 per member per day \$ 5.00

Family Guest, 1 per member per day \$ 20.00 (daily max per family)

No more than 2 guest will be allowed on 1 host member guest sign in and no more than 1 family will be allowed on one host family member guest sign in.

Host Members are responsible for their guest and must accompany them at all times.

Please refer to the Pool Hours & Rules for additional GUEST Privileges posted at the Pool and on Coulwood.org website.

All Pool rentals require a separate request for lifeguards with Charlotte Swim Club Management (CSCM). Rates and cost is dependent on the age and number of people attending the function.
